Addendum to NSSM 103

In connection with the papers being prepared in response to NSSM 103, it is also requested that a paper be prepared on the status of the U.S. response to the following Israeli requests for economic assistance:

- 1. \$50 million in supporting assistance.
- 2. \$85 million in PL 480 assistance.
- 3. Request for access to the proceeds of the German offset loan.
- 4. Assistance in desalting.
- 5. Request for additional El Al landing rights.
- 6. Request for special treatment on textiles.
- 7. Request to be treated as a lower income country for purposes of eligibility to compete for AID procurement.

This memorandum should state a proposed U.S. position on each of these issues with appropriate explanation and alternatives in any case where there are significant ones.

This memorandum should be coordinated by the NSCIG/NEA and forwarded to the NSC Senior Review Group by November 27.
